Experience: Marcia Williams was a charter member of EPA in 1970 and spent 18 years at the Agency. She held senior management positions in the area of solid and hazardous waste regulation and in the area of pesticide and toxic chemical regulation. Since leaving EPA, she held a senior environmental position at Browning Ferris Industries, a large international waste management company, and served on the Board of Directors of Safety-Kleen Corporation, a recycling company.

She has spent the last 25 years consulting for a wide range of companies and government entities.
